PROCEEDINGS OF EC MEETING HELD ON 20-10-21

No 1137

Date 29-10-21

- 1. The Executive Committee** had its 1st sitting on 20-10-21 after its re-constitution by the Higher Education Department, vide Notification No. 26837 dated 08-07-21. Given the critical situations, the sitting was broadened in scope by inviting representatives from the existing Old Students Association, all staff members of the College and students' representatives in the 1st session of the meeting from 11.00AM to 2.00 PM. This session was devoted to the presentations of various developmental aspects of the College and simultaneous discussions on the presentations, vide, Appendix-C. The discussions were marked by serious allegations and counter- allegations immediately after the address of the Principal and during presentations on various aspects assigned to designated teachers. Prof., Sukanta Kumar Tripathy, Department of Physics, Berhampur University, and University nominee on Executive Committee discussed at length the role and necessary work to be done for 2nd cycle NAAC accreditation in the shortest possible time. He expressed his agreement on the proposal submitted by the Principal for scoring good grade in NAAC assessment and offered to assist in this matter. The session began with inaugural formalities and address by the Principal. The session was chaired by Mr Tirtha Jani, Chairman of the Executive committee. The Principal in his address made a brief mention of the problems of the College and cited all the achievements during his term as Principal I/C from 01-07-20 to 19-10-21, vide, Appendix-B (3/3). The chairman in his final address emphasized on more and better co-operation and co-ordination among staff members, and between staff members and the Principal for successful delivery of educational services. The first session ended with a vote of thanks to the chair, EC members, staff members, media persons, alumni representatives, students, and volunteers.
- 2. The 2nd session** began from 3.00 PM for presentation of documents for verification and approval. During this session only EC members participated. The details of documents presented to EC members for verification, remark & approval were given in Appendix-D. One special matter on which the Chairman seemed to disagree about the expenditure that

was made for relocation of the examination section, and for safety and security measures for the college, the Principal defended the necessity and procedure adopted for the expenditure and chose to leave the matter to audit for verification if any irregularity had been done in following standard procedure for the expenditure. On other matters of documents presented for verification, the EC members were satisfied about the policies taken and implemented. However, there were suggestions for clearing up the dues of BSNL adopting government standard procedure. The Principal thanked the Chairman and the EC members for having checked the documents of policies taken and implemented. The meeting was declared closed by the Chairman at 5.00PM.

3. **This sitting** of EC was successful in the following aspects:
 - a. Creating awareness among staff and EC members about the critical needs of the College, particularly, the 2nd cycle NAAC accreditation and sustaining the autonomous status which has expired in 2016-17.
 - b. Presentations of the achievements and future proposals for necessary actions
 - c. Documents verification & Approval by EC members about the policies adopted with respect to online examination, alternative valuation, hostel fees collection, fees regulation for examination section, land issues of the College and other aspects of the documents' presentations as given in Appendices.

5. **The College** was blessed with commencement of management activities by Executive Committee after its re-constitution. In fact, the previous meeting of Governing Body was held on 28-12-2018 with Mr Ranjan Kumar Mahalik as Principal I/C and Ex-officio secretary to the Governing body. The members were hopeful for another meeting in this year in the shortest possible time.

ADDRESS BY PRINCIPAL-CUM-SECRETARY

SUB: MEETING OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON 20-10-2021

1. **Honourable Chairman** of the Executive Committee, all members of the Committee, Invited members from Old Students Association, all staff members of the College present here, and students selected to this Meeting, and Press persons present here. I, as Ex-Officio secretary to Executive Committee, welcome all of you to this sitting of the Executive Committee. It is my responsibility to inform you the present status of the functioning of the College and to present before you the challenges that the College faces and tasks that are to be performed. I hope, this sitting would address the problems for effective functioning of the College maintaining expected standard in coming years. One hopes, this would fulfil the needs of the society.
2. **This is the 1st Meeting** after the Government Notification of present Executive Committee. The single most important task at now for the College is to get NAAC accredited to continue with the status as an Autonomous College. This College was NAAC accredited with Grade B for a period of five years. The validity period is gone, though the College is running effectively as an Autonomous College. I may inform you that NAAC accreditation is a periodic affair for sustaining the national educational standard. A lot of benefits attach to this status besides being a public image for the District of Kandhamal. As such, periodic accreditation with growing grade, is an absolute necessity. The College has to achieve the standards prescribed in various aspects of its functioning to continue as an Autonomous College.
3. **I would like to** inform you the developments from 1st July 2020 when I was given additional duty of Principal because of service seniority among the teachers. For better running of classes, conduct of examinations, security of the premises and as preparation to the NAAC accreditation in future the following tasks were accomplished:
 - a. Shifting of Examination Section to the New Building and housing it in 03 rooms

- b. Eliminating additional department-cum-class rooms for better use of room space for classes and other requirements
 - c. Renovation of rooms as required
 - d. Blocking all unnecessary pathways running through the College premises and creating a separate entrance for the Govt HS School, Phulbani that shares room space with us
 - e. Creating a green front of the College by planting decorative plants along the premises passes and a small garden in front of the Main Building
 - f. Hostel administration has been streamlined
 - g. Efforts for payments in Examination Section through banking system for financial discipline and avoiding unnecessary advances whenever feasible
 - h. Conduct of online examinations
 - i. High Court Matters
4. **The following** basic information may provide the context for discussion:
- a. Shortage of regular faculty members
 - b. Vacancy in the posts of Library
 - c. Lack of basic automation of examination tasks
 - d. Lack of library automation
 - e. Non-functioning of Wi-Fi system
 - f. Non-functioning of IT aides in classrooms
5. **The details** of presentation shall be made as per the agenda of the Meeting. I hope discussion and debates should go along with presentation of specific activity by the teacher entrusted. In the end I would hope a fruitful discussion of the challenges and the undertaking of the tasks involved.



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

1. CONTEXT OF THE REGULATION

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the usual process of conducting examination could not be carried out for Theory & Practical examination of Even Semesters of 2019-20. HE (Govt. of Odisha) letter No. 19513 dated 18-06-2020 has suggested adoption of alternative methods of evaluation for publication of results of Intermediate Semesters of 2019-20 in conformity with guidelines of UGC. Hence, the necessity for this Regulation. This regulation is purely Ad hoc in nature and the methods adopted apply for papers which could not be evaluated by usual examination process in the Even Semesters of 2019-20.

2. PAPERS NOT TO BE EVALUATED BY ALTERNATIVE METHODS

Alternative Methods of Evaluation (AME) will not be adopted for the following papers

- a. Papers for which examinations have been conducted, and hence marks are available.
- b. Improvement examinations, if any. Students who have applied for Improvement Examinations are to appear for these examinations in subsequent physical mode of examinations, when these will be held.
- c. Back Papers of UG Sem-II & PG Sem-II of 2019-20. These papers can be cleared when normal examinations will be held.

3. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL MECHANISM

Students dissatisfied with the marks awarded by AME may appear for the Special Examination with an undertaking that the mark secured in the Special Examination is to be recorded as final irrespective of whether the mark obtained is higher or lower than the marks awarded by AME.

4. ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF EVALUATION(AME)

ONLINE EXAMINATIONS REGULATION: 2021

1. CONTEXT & OBJECTIVES:

This Regulation shall be called the **ONLINE EXAMINATIONS REGULATION OF GOVERNMENT AUTONOMOUS COLLEGE, PHULBANI, ODISHA**. This regulation is framed to regulate online examinations to be conducted pursuant to the Letter No. 25110 /HE dated 28-06-2021 of Higher Education, Odisha for conduct of Final Degree Examinations and BACK/IMPROVEMENET of Final Degree Students and Ex-students of 2020-21. As the entire design of the online examination was left to the College, this regulation is made to achieve transparency in the following matters within the constraints of existing technology:

1. Details of exam processes
2. Details of Marks/Question types, time duration etc.
3. Mode of delivery of Questions and other Documents
4. Mode of receipt of answer books
5. Mentoring System
6. MP Cases

1. COVERAGE OF EXMINATIONS

The regulation covers the conduct of Mid Sem and End Sem Examinations. It includes regular, back, and improvement examinations of Undergraduate and Post Graduate Programmes for theory and practical part of the papers.

2. ONLINE EXAM PROCESS

The examination process includes the following:

- 2.1. **REGISTRATION**-This shall be done using specially designed GOOGLE FORM. Bona fide students, i.e., who have taken re-admission for 2020-21, and Ex-students attempting completion of a programme of study shall be allowed to register for online examinations. Eligibility for appearing Back and Improvement Examinations shall remain the same as with traditional examinations. **No student is allowed to appear examination in a particular paper more than one time to clear back papers in a particular academic session** Students shall pay through Bank Draft drawn in favour of Principal, Government Autonomous College, Phulbani, payable at Phulbani. The Bank Draft has to be sent to the College by Post. A student has to supply the required information in GOOGLE FORM for examinations. The student shall be issued an automatic copy of the Registered Form immediately on registration . Any discrepancy in fees payable and paid shall be paid on intimation of the same. A single Registration has to be done for all examinations a student desires to appear. However, fees shall be calculated as per the rates for different examinations, and the total amount has to be paid through Bank Draft. No examination shall be allowed without registration backed by required deposit of fees in the form of Bank Draft. The student can collect the College Receipt later on production of Response receipt at the College Counter. No registration shall be done for Mid Sem Examinations.
- 2.2. **CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS**- A student can appear the examination from any place other than the College. The detail notifications shall be issued about the schedules of different examinations. Questions shall be supplied in soft form in the College Website, Twitter Account of the Controller of Examinations and WhatsApps groups maintained by the different departments and mentors. **Questions shall be supplied 30 minutes in advance of the scheduled time. A student shall get another 1 hour after the completion of the examination time for submission of answer book**

in PDF format to the appropriate mentor through email account along with details of examination appeared. The student shall be issued a copy of the response of the GOOGLE FORM that shall be used for collection of answer books. A student shall be asked to upload his/her answer book in the GOOGLE FORM used for collection of answer books. Extra time of 1 hr shall be given to the differently abled students provided they submit the eligible document.

2.3. FULL MARKS AND QUESTION TYPES

2.3.1. MID SEMS-There is no change with respect to full marks and question pattern for Mid Sems from that of Physical mode of examination. Duration shall be of 1 hour as in traditional examinations.

2.3.2. END SEMS- the following changes have been made in the End Sem Exams:

2.3.2.1. THEORY PAPER WITHOUT PRACTICAL COMPONENT (EXCEPT ENGLISH)-

Total Mark for each Paper shall be of **40** Marks instead of 80 Marks. Time duration shall be of **2 hours**. There shall be compulsory 05 objective questions each carrying 02 marks. A student has to write any **03** long questions out of 05 questions, each question shall carry 10 marks. The long questions shall be of either- or format from all 05 units of the syllabus.

2.3.2.2. PAPERS OF ENGLISH-The traditional pattern shall be followed. Students shall appear for total 40 marks in each paper. They have to write 02 questions out of 04 from units meant for End Sem examinations, as approved in the syllabus.

2.3.2.3. PAPER WITH PRACTICAL COMPONENT- - Total Mark for each Paper shall be of **25** Marks instead of 50 Marks. Time duration is of **2 hours**. There shall be compulsory 05 objective questions each carrying 02 marks. A student has to write any **03** long questions out of 05 questions, each question shall carry 5 marks. There shall be of either- or format from all 05 units of the syllabus.

2.3.2.4. PRACTICAL EXAMINATION-There is no change in the full mark for practical question. The mode of examinations shall be the responsibility of the department depending on technology availability and time


constraint. Details of practical examinations can be obtained from the HOD of concerned subject.

3. **SECURITY PROVISION AND MP CASES**- A student cannot submit his answerbook to anybody except to the mentor through the designated email. He/She is not allowed to display his/her answer books to other either physically or supplying soft copy in any media. Such cases shall be booked under MP, and the existing rule shall be maintained. The student is required to maintain the hard copy of the answer book. He/She is required to use **A4 computer paper for First Page and Writing pages of answerbooks. Only black ball/gel pens are allowed.** The First Page of answer book has to be of the Format that shall be prescribed. Each answer book shall be 01(one file) PDF file only, including the First Page.
4. **MENTORING SYSTEM**- A mentoring system shall function right from the Registration to the Publication of the results. A student is required to get solution of his/her exam related problems from his/her mentor. The email and mobile number of mentors shall be notified on website/twitter/whatsApps groups.



